## Who we help?

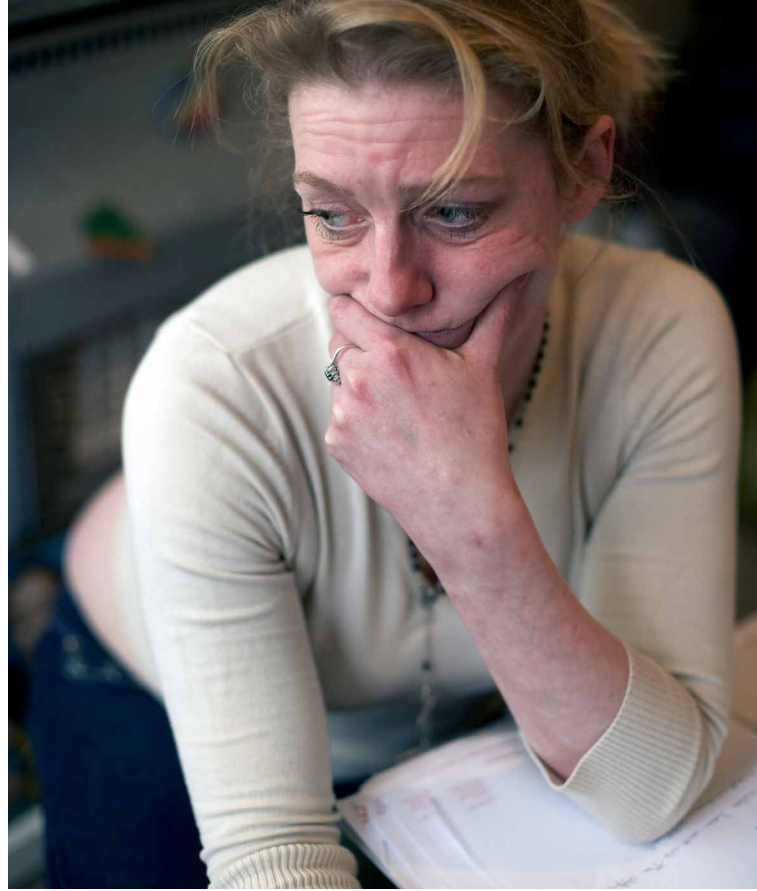
We can help if you're an individual living in Birmingham with a variety of complex needs:
